Rules and Conditions

1. All birds must be penned by 10 am
2. No substitution of entries permitted.
3. Judging commences at 11 am.
4. Access to the judging area is restricted to the Judge and Stewards.
5. It is a condition of Entry that no bird may be removed before 4.30pm and must be removed before 5.30pm.
6. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to enter the exhibits in the correct class.
7. The breed name of each bird must be given on the entry form.
8. Where 3 or more birds of one breed are entered in a class, a separate class may be arranged at the discretion of the Judge(s).
9. Eggs must be displayed on plates provided on the Show day by Stewards.

8. Straw bedding only, No woodchip or paper.
